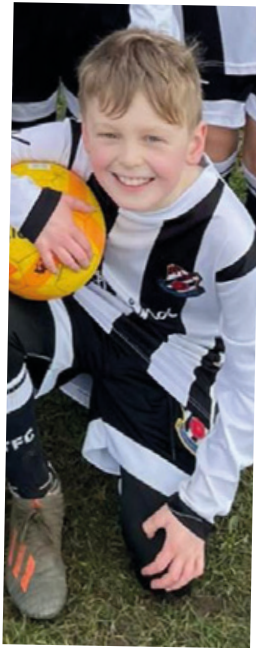
The Prestbury Phantoms Wildcats are about to embark on their second season in the Cheltenham Youth League.

# OWEN BEVAN

Cheltenham Town have continued their busy Summer in the transfer market, bolstering their squad with the addition of Owen Bevan, the young captain of AFC Bournemouth's development squad.

The 19-year-old has been with the Cherries since he was nine and has made real strides of progress in recent seasons, following loan moves to Truro City and Yeovil Town mixed in with a Premier League and League Cup debut for Bournemouth.

"I'm buzzing to join the club," began Bevan.

"I think it is a big step in my career to come up to League One and it is exactly what I need and I'm looking forward to the challenge."

Similar to fellow new signing Luciano D'Auria-Henry, Bevan started his footballing career further forward on the pitch as a central midfielder before moving back to the heart of the defence aged 14.

An experience that has shaped the player the Robins are taking on.

"As a player most importantly, it's always defend first. I like to be aggressive and play on the front foot, but I also like to be able to play a bit as well. Nice and composed."

The change in position was facilitated during his time at Bournemouth, a club he credits greatly for his footballing journey to this point. Bevan

made his way through the academy system in Dorset before making his aforementioned Premier League debut at Anfield last season.

"The club has changed a lot since I've been there. When I joined, they were just getting promoted from League One and now they are a pretty established Premier League club. I've loved it there and it has really helped my development."

Bevan made 31 appearances during his time with Yeovil last term. Whilst this is his first move to a football league club, those loan moves to clubs in the non-league structure have given him the belief to succeed at a higher level.

"Playing men's football is exactly what I need at this stage of my career. League One will be a big challenge for myself and I think I can do that. In my position of centre-half, it is good coming up against big strong strikers as it prepares me for my career."

After being on the bench against Northampton Town last weekend, the defender is raring to go and introduce himself to the Robins faithful.

"It will be good to get out in front of fans and will be good to get the first win of the season as well."

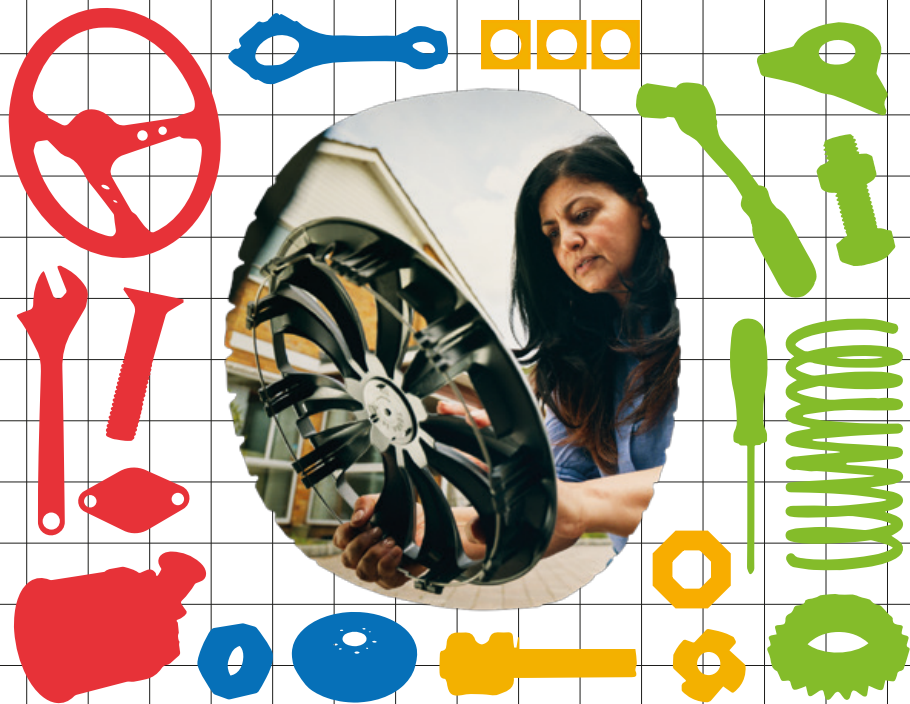

**Barnsley are beginning their second consecutive season in the third tier of English football for the first time since 2015/16 after a heartbreaking play-off final defeat to rivals Sheffield Wednesday at the end of last term.**

A 1-0 defeat in stoppage time of extra time under the Wembley arch curtailed an immediate return to the Championship and consigned the Tykes to another season in League One. Now with Neill Collins in charge, after former Cheltenham player and manager Michael Duff moved onto Swansea, the club will be desperate to go one step further and return to the second tier for the first time since the 2021/22 season.

After the highs of finishing in the play-off spots in the Championship in the 2021, they currently occupy 12th spot in League One after an indifferent start to the new season. A thumping 7-0 win over Port Vale kicked off the campaign before they went three games without a win in the league. However, a 2-0 win on the road to 10-man Wigan Athletic last time out has steadied the ship ahead of a trip south to the Completely-Suzuki Stadium.

Devante Cole has once again been key for the

Tykes this term with five goals in the opening five games, looking well on his way to bettering his 16-goal tally last season. Operating around him are several important members from last season's squad. Midfield duo Adam Phillips and Luca Connell stand out as the key to making the team tick with the latter recently being named in the Professional Footballers Association League One Team of the Year.

Phillips and Connell both featured in Barnsley's 4-0 win when they visited the Robins' home for the first time in a competitive game last season and they will be keen to replicate a similar result.

Additionally, there have been new arrivals too in forwards John McAtee and Max Watters, returning permanently after his loan spell from Cardiff City last term. Defensive reinforcements have also been made, with Frenchman Mael de Gevigney coming in to try and replace the gap left by the departing Mads Andersen who moved onto Luton Town after four years in Yorkshire.

The new faces and those who have remained at the club know a return to the Championship is the goal for the club's fans and ownership. After a mixed start an upturn in form is needed to achieve that as the opening month of the new season draws to a close.

# IT'S #HERGAMETOO

In 2021, a group of passionate women fans felt mobilised to start a campaign called #HerGameToo.

The campaign is committed to fostering an ethos in football where women are welcomed and respected equally and can be confident sharing their opinions about football online and in person without fear of sexist abuse. This afternoon, we introduce two new advocates to the cause.

Cheltenham Town's Her Game Too ambassador, Kelly-Marie Selby, tells us: "Growing up loving football, it was so sad that not only did girls not have the opportunities that boys had to further their abilities, but trying to voice my opinion was almost impossible. As soon as I tried to express any views I was told I was a girl, I didn't know anything about football, and I should just concentrate on make up and being a girl.

"The younger me shied away from fighting, but as I got older, I knew this wasn't right and that I should be allowed to join in on conversations about football. So when the opportunity came to become an ambassador of an amazing campaign to empower women to have a voice without fear, I put myself forward. Over the past few months I've been ambassador for Her Game Too Cheltenham, and this has now grown

with two incredible ladies coming on board - Mary Stone and Taz Scales.

"Together, we want to help create an environment at The Completely-Suzuki Stadium where women of all ages can feel welcome and safe without fear of sexism and misogyny, knowing there are avenues to report such incidents."

Introducing themselves, Taz explained: "53 years ago the ban of woman playing football was finally lifted, and now we are seeing woman on the big screens influencing the new generation. Her Game Too brings awareness to the struggles woman players and fans may face and how we can eliminate it. I am so excited to work alongside Her Game Too to raise more awareness and inspire the younger generations."

Alongside Taz and Kelly-Marie, Mary reflected on what the campaign is for her: "Her Game Too means being able to go and watch football games wherever I want, whenever I want,

without being made uncomfortable. In the short space of time I've been involved with this group, I've connected with so many female football friends, like Kelly and Taz, and sharing our experiences together shows exactly why we're doing what we're doing.

"I'd encourage everyone to find a way to get involved with Her Game Too, it could be through doing something so simple as wearing our badge or taking a more front facing role in tackling sexism in football."

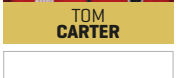
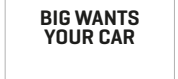
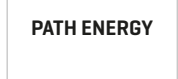
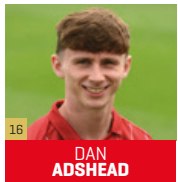
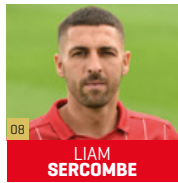
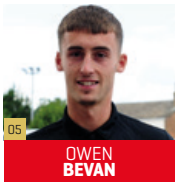
